John 1:14-17 NLT

So, the Word became human and made his home among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness. And we have seen his glory, the glory of the Father's one and only Son. John testified about him when he shouted to the crowds, "This is the one I was talking about when I said, 'Someone is coming after me who is far greater than I am, for he existed long before me.'" From his abundance, we have all received one gracious blessing after another. For the law was given through Moses, but God's unfailing love and faithfulness came through Jesus Christ.

"Help me know your unfailing love and faithfulness."

Remember that old song by Journey called, Faithfully? In it, the singer belts out a ballad of devotion and the lyrics sing, "I get the joy of rediscovering you. Oh girl, you stand by me. I'm forever yours. Faithfully."

Faithfulness is a quality we all long to experience. Whether in friendships, family relationships, or marriage, there is something deeply comforting about knowing someone will remain steadfast and true. Yet, even in the most dedicated of relationships, we experience disappointment.

John the Baptist understood God's faithfulness long before he understood God's plan. He trusted that God would keep His promises, and recognized Jesus as the fulfillment of those promises. God kept His promises then and remains faithful today. When we look back on our lives, we can often see His hand guiding, providing, protecting, and redeeming in ways we may not have noticed in the moment. His grace continues to meet us just where we are and is always right on time.

As we celebrate God's faithfulness, we are also called to share it. Our stories of God's provision, mercy, and love can encourage others who may be struggling to trust him. Just as John's testimony pointed people to Jesus, our stories can help others seek God's goodness and draw closer to Him.

Our God is unfailing and sings over you, "I'm forever yours, faithfully."
