Theme: Sharing God's Story

Acts 8:4 NLT

But the believers who were scattered preached the Good News about Jesus wherever they went.

“Wherever I am, help me share who you are.”

There is something fascinating about those that boldly proclaim their faith in public. Whether standing on a street corner offering prayer to strangers or speaking Scripture over a hurting person on the beach, we are reminded that the message of Jesus is too important to keep to ourselves.

Most of us may not feel called to stand on a box in the middle of a busy intersection, but we are all called to share God's story. In Acts 8:4, the author writes of how early believers in Jesus could not keep the Good News to themselves. They didn't wait for the perfect setup or a formal ministry situation. If they were standing on the shore and found themselves next to another fisherman, they shared the Gospel. When they entered the marketplace, they talked about Jesus. When gathered in their homes with their friends, their conversations included stories of their Savior.

Romans 1:16 reminds us not to be ashamed of the Gospel. We can share all that God has done, is doing, and will continue to do with those in our lives with boldness and intentionality. It may look like giving God credit for a blessing, offering to pray for someone in a difficult season, or sharing how God has been faithful during a personal challenge. As we walk through life with intentionality and faith, God opens doors of opportunity to step out courageously and share His love.

Share: Has anyone influenced you by sharing their faith? What impact did that have on your life? What is difficult about sharing your faith with others? Describe an experience when you had an opportunity to share God's story. What happened? What has God done in your life that could be something someone else needs to hear? What are some simple ways to share Jesus in everyday conversations? What would it look like to share God's story “wherever you go” this month?

Suggested Prayer Topics

- Pray for global evangelism. Pray that every woman everywhere would be reconciled to God through Jesus Christ.
